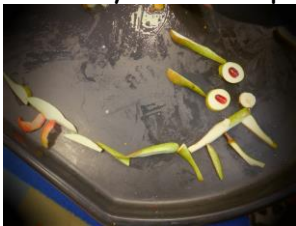
YEAR 3 & 4
