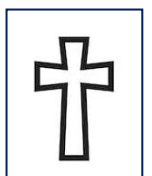

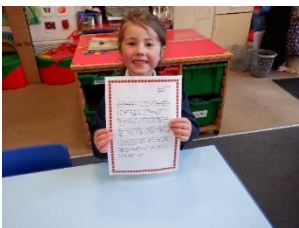
Annabelle for amazing fully explaining answers to comprehension questions.
