**Jess** in for very careful, accurate and beautifully presented, facial features colour mixing skills.

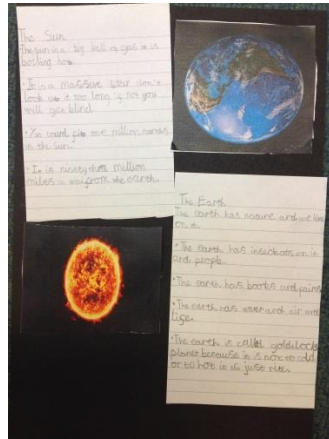

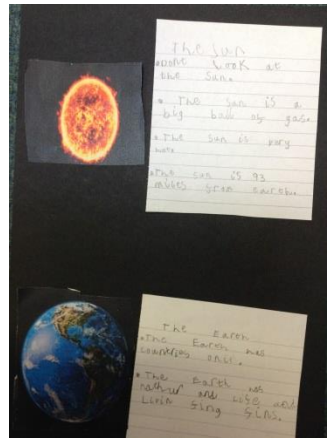
### INFANTS



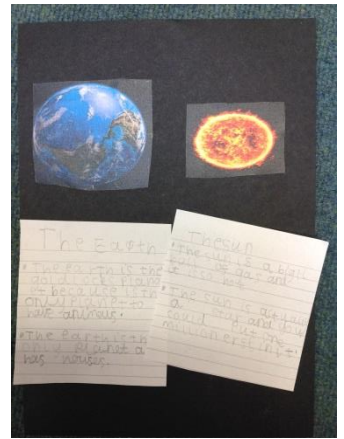
